Gulf Wars Camp Beautification Challenge

Mission Statement: To encourage the atmosphere of a medieval town in the camping areas.

Goal: To encourage the removal or camouflaging of modern accoutrements, camp cohesiveness, group participation.

This is NOT a Kingdom vs Kingdom competition. Or a bus stop competition.

Method: Through the use of friendly competition, with future bragging rights preserved, individual camps that choose to participate will be judged on their adherence to that year's theme, their creativity in hiding modern conveniences, and their overall success in presenting their camp as a period home site.

Registration for your camping area: Registration will be conducted at troll. A numbered flag will be provided upon registration of camp. A representative of your camp must be present at time of Judging.

Judging:

Theme-- Will be announced yearly in January prior to event.

Official judges-- chosen by autocrats & department heads.

Announcements will be made.

Populace and judges—will do a Camp Crawl to look at the pretty camps and cast votes of registered entrants

Judging sheet-- (see attached)

6 categories of judging with 1 overall Grand Prize.

1 winner: overall grand prize

1 winner: best use of theme

1 winner: Best parameter (curb appeal – outside as seen from road)

1 winner: best common area (inside camp communal area)

1 winner: best sca life portrayal (covering of modern things)

1 winner: the camp with the most people participating while being judged.

Timing-- Judging done on Thursday, winners announced on Friday.

Details--

Budget \$50 for plaques

Once judging is done some form of notice will be displayed with the numbered flag to indicate camp has been judged.

A representative from the camp being judged must be present at judging.
