

Cry Herald Standard Operating Procedures

The function of the Cry heralds will be to vocally disseminate information across site in the morning, after lunch, and any other time as needed.

1. The Cry Heralds will meet outside the Watch at Five Points at 1:00 pm on the first Sunday for a meet and greet and to be informed of the job duties and their specified zone. Thereafter Cry Heralds will notify the Cry Herald Head daily via text that they heralded their scheduled zone by the end of each day . Cry tours of site will begin at 8am and 1pm.
2. Morning and Afternoon Tours – announce the schedule for the morning (armor inspection, activities, classes, changes, weather forecast, etc.) including location.
3. Be available for any emergency announcements including inclement weather. 4.

Routes for each tour will be decided by the Cry Heralds during the first meeting.

5. Tours will begin on the Monday of war and end with the Saturday morning shift at the end of

war.
