

SOP for Live Weapons

Proposed Budget for Live Weapons to buy 40 Straw Bales, Fifteen 2x4x8 boards (5) per TW Target, and Twenty-60cm targets for Archery, marking paint for range distances.

Place an order for Straw Bales when Autocrats call for it. autocrat@gulfwars.org

For Archery and Thrown Weapons a total of forty straw bales will be needed.

Before War

Submit deputy update to webminister@gulfwars.org

They will need SCA name, Modern name, email address for all.

Submit early on list to early-on@gulfwars.org

They will need SCA name, Modern name, Position held (Rider for family members) for all.

Submit schedule changes to scheduler@gulfwars.org

Send a reminder to Liaison.royal@gulfwars.org that each Kingdom should pick two representatives for their Kingdom for the Friday Finale for Archery.

You will need to design the War Point for Thrown Weapons, Target Archers and create the Friday Finale Shoot for Archery.

There will need to be made up Twenty 60cm archery targets. Glueing them to cardboard makes them last longer.

Thrown weapon targets that match the following: The smallest circle shall be 3" in diameter; the next largest circle shall be 8" in diameter and the outer circle shall be 14" in diameter. You will need cardboard for the spear targets and the knife and axe can be drawn on the wood targets.

Items needed every year:

30x30 tent

Twelve chairs

Radio

One Week Before War

Early on allowed. Fill in your list of helpers.

Storage is open Thursday through Sunday. They have a list of everything we own.

Live Weapons equipment is stored in the back of the trailer.

You will need to pick up twelve chairs from the supply point. (Near the war field)

Water coolers should be delivered and checked daily.

Once tent is set up you can mark the shooting and throwing lines. Mark the different distances on the ground with marking paint as some Kingdoms will want to move targets for their shoots.

You will need the following measurements:

Archery:

Ten yards - one target (3 straw bales)

Fifteen yards - one target (3 straw bales)

Twenty yards - three targets (6 straw bales, one wood frame target butt)

Thirty yards - three targets (6 straw bales, one wood frame target butt)

Forty yards - three targets (6 straw bales, one wood frame target butt)

Clout / Long range (3 straw bales)

Thrown Weapons:

Ten foot - wood target x2

Fifteen foot – wood x2 and three straw bales

Twenty foot – wood and three straw bales

Twenty-five foot - three straw bales.

4 spare bales to replace busted bales for Thrown Weapons.

Pick up MIC packets for time keeping. Usually on Friday evening before war week starts. You will have to pick up a radio every morning and turn it and your time sheets in every evening.

During War

A different Kingdom runs each day, and they should provide the marshals to inspect and run the line.

Monday, Trimaris

Tuesday, Ansteorra

Wednesday, Meridies

Thursday, Calontir

Friday, Gleann Abhann

Range teardown is Saturday.

Round Targets go in first, Archery netting, supply containers, rebar, flag poles, five tables, three chairs, any unused wood boards, TW targets and stands. (Turn in Lost and Found items to the Watch.)

Supply point chairs (12) must go back.

Straw bales to fill in holes or place in woods.

Clean area of all litter and trash.

Collect all unused time sheets and turn them in with folder.

Let the Autocrats know the area is complete.
